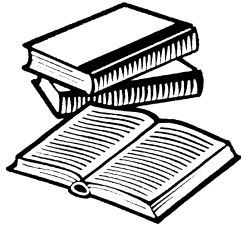

Summer Reading @ Arapahoe Libraries

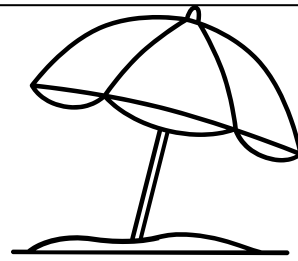
Readers aged 0-18 can participate from June 1 - Aug. 3. Pick up Summer Reading passports at the library.
